

Access to and from Narita Airport Route Search Service

The Keisei website includes a route search service with Narita Airport specified as the departure and arrival point. Entry and search results are provided in English.

How to use

- 1) Enter the names of your departing and arriving stations.
 - *Please enter the station names in English.
 - *For Narita Airport, departure and arrival can be switched.
- 2) Specify the date and time of your departure or arrival.
 - *Specify either the departure time or the arrival time.
- 3) Select display in order of time or display in order of number of transfers.
- 4) Click "Search".
