**From September 1 (Sunday)**

Beginning September 1, 2019, Keisei Electric Railway Co., Ltd. (Head office: Ichikawa City, Chiba; President: Toshiya Kobayashi) will accept the leading Chinese Alipay and WeChat Pay mobile payment services for purchases made at the SKYLINER & KEISEI INFORMATION CENTERS (Narita Airport Terminal 1 Station and Narita Airport Terminal 2-3 Station), Skyliner ticket sales counters (Narita Airport Terminal 1 and Narita Airport Terminal 2-3, Nippori, Keisei Uneo), and the Keisei Railway Ticket Sales Counter located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Narita Airport Terminal 1 building.

In response to the growing number of travelers visiting Japan from China, in February of This year Keisei Electric Railway introduced Alipay and WeChat Pay as payment methods for the Skyliner e-ticket Internet ticket purchase service for international visitors to Japan, through which visitors can use the Internet to purchase Keisei Skyliner limited express tickets and passenger tickets and other products before their visit to Japan.

Now by accepting Alipay and WeChat Pay for payment at Skyliner ticket sales counters in Japan as well allows visitors to purchase Keisei Skyliner limited express tickets and passenger tickets as well as other products at Skyliner ticket sales counters, including at Narita Airport, after arriving in Japan without needing to exchange currency for Japanese yen, greatly improving convenience for those visitors.

Going forward, Keisei Electric Railway Co., Ltd. will continue to expand a variety of services for international visitors to Japan in order to make their visits to Japan more comfortable, convenient, and enjoyable.
